Class 1: 18 years and over - Open Class (BD Novice 27 (2007) & approx. 3ft jumps). The Kinnaird Cup' will be awarded to the highest paced NEFRC member.

Class 2: 17 years and under - Open Class (BD Novice 27 (2007) & approx. 3ft jumps)

Class 3: 18 years and over - Novice Class (BD Prelim 14 (2006) & approx. 2ft6 jumps). The Paddock Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the highest paced NEFRC member.

Class 4: 17 years and under - Novice Class (BD Prelim 14 (2006) & approx. 2ft6 jumps)

Class 5: 18 years and over - Nursery Novice Class (BD Prelim 1 (2006) & approx. 2ft jumps). The NEFRC Salver will be awarded to the highest paced NEFRC member.

Class 6: 17 years and under - Nursery Novice (BD Prelim 1 (2006) & approx. 2ft jumps)

Rosettes to 6th place. Entry fees which includes first aid cover: NEFRC members* £40 and non-members £45. A start fee of £5 will be payable when you pick up your number.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser but will cost an additional £10.

Entries Close Monday 6th July and must be pre-paid.

No telephone entries under any circumstances.

As a condition of entry, NEFRC members will be expected to either help with the set up or dismantle days, or nominate a friend or family member who is willing to jump judge.

The course may be walked from 2pm on Saturday 11th July. For Sat Navs the postcode is KY15 5TW. Directions are available on the course website: www.kinnairdcrosscountry.co.uk

The XC phase will be run over a lengthened course rather than the usual training course. **Green** (2ft), blue (2ft6) and pink (approx. 3ft).

Rules of the Course

Your safety is <u>your</u> responsibility. We do not accept liability for any accident, injury, illness, loss or damage to you, your horse, your vehicle or your belongings whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

- 1. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 2. All riders must wear a hat to the current approved standard (correctly fastened, no fixed peak) when mounted. Body protectors and medical armbands must be worn when jumping. If you are wearing an air jacket, please bring your own number bib and print off your own number and register with the secretary. If you are wearing a cage body protector please ensure the key is handed into the secretary.
- 3. Please be aware that this is a working farm and there may be machinery or stock moving about. Children should be closely supervised and dogs (on leads) must be under control at all times.
- 4. By signing the disclaimer below you are agreeing to abide by the rules. An adult must sign for any rider under 18 years old.
- 5. Anyone riding should ensure that they are covered for third party public liability insurance.
- 6. No watches or hat-cams allowed.
- 7. There will be 'L' fences at the more difficult fences on the course. 15 penalties are incurred for jumping an 'L' fence.
- 8. Entry fees will be refunded only for withdrawals presented in writing before the closing date.
- 9. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned less £10 for administration.
- 10. Refreshments will be on sale.
- 11. Class numbers may be restricted.
- 12. Trophies are awarded on an annual basis and must be returned to the organisers when requested.
- 13. Bibs should be collected from the secretary upon presentation of your £5 start fee.
- 14. The organiser's decision is final.
- 15. Competition will be run under the BRC Rules of Competition. Please note that combinations eliminated in the SJ phase will not be permitted to continue to the XC phase.
- 16. Competitors eliminated on the cross country **MAY** be allowed to continue at the organisers discretion, but if so, only have <u>one</u> attempt at each fence and **MUST** give way to oncoming horses.
- 17. There will be no farrier present on the field.
- 18. The on-call vet will be Loch Leven Equine Practice.
- 19. Stabling may be available please contact Lesley Howat on 01334 653306 or 07821 495865 for details.
